GCSE DANCE	Description
GCSE Set Phrases Masterclass	Ideal for exam preparation. Helping Students refine the set phrases focusing on: precision, musicality, dynamics, performance quality.
GCSE Choreography Boost	<p>Helps students generate ideas from stimulus and develop choreography. Avoiding the "I don't know what to create" problem</p> <p>Students explore: motif development, variations of canon, repetition, choreographic devices</p> <p>Students leave with clear ideas they can use for their exam choreography.</p>
GCSE Duet/Trio Development	<p>Focused on collaborative choreography task</p> <p>Students explore: partnering ideas, formations, spatial design, Choreographic transition , interaction between dancers. This could include creating the duet/Trio, or developing a pre existing work.</p>
GCSE Choreography Rescue Session	<p>For groups stuck with their choreography. Students bring their work and we: refocus, refine sections, improve transitions, develop motifs and ideas, increase originality</p> <p>Could also include a mock exam, with outside eyes a predicted grade in it current condition</p>

A Level Choreography Intensive	<p>Advanced choreographic development tool including: motif manipulation, thematic development, structure and abstraction, creative exploration.</p> <p>Perfect for A Level exam choreography preparation.</p>
A Level Performance Skills Coaching	<p>Focused on developing to help students improve: performance quality, stage presence, dynamic range, Physical and mental Stamina for performance, expressive movement</p>
A level Practical Creative Research & Development	<p>Helping dancers generate stronger choreography concepts. Students explore: stimulus interpretation, thematic development, artistic intention, creative process</p>
A level Mock Exam	<p>Perfect for dancer prior to submission of practical aspects of the qualification. Giving detailed feedback with clear directed targets, on strengths and areas for development.</p>
